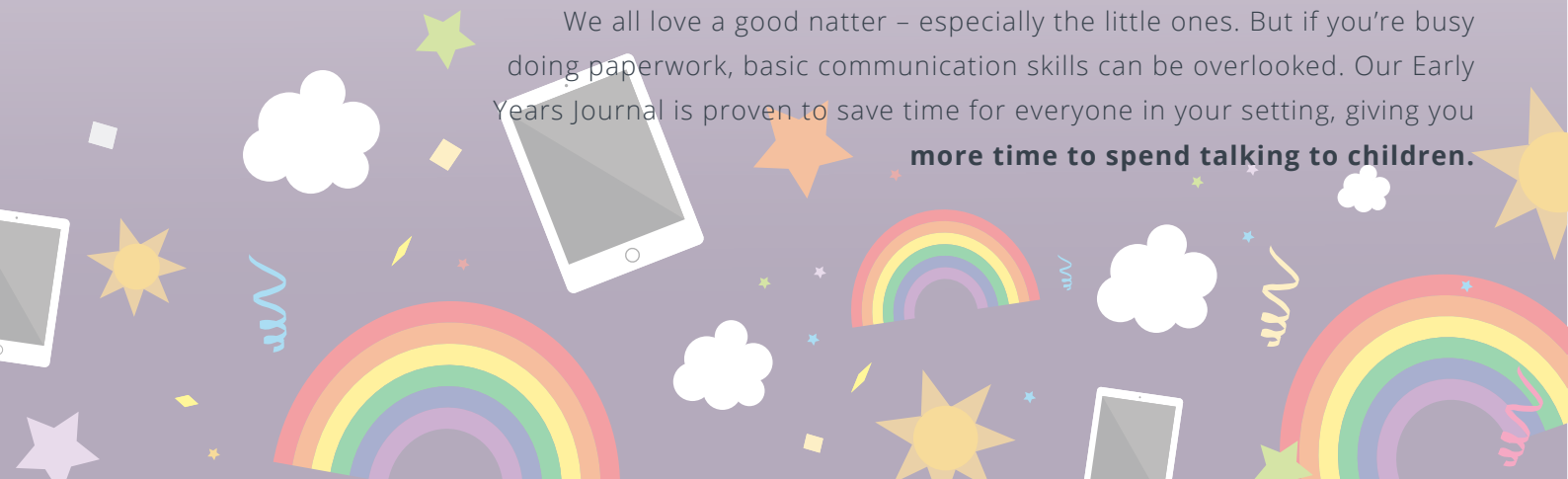


COMMUNICATION IS KEY
